Agenda Item:	Welcome and Approval of Minutes – Doug Bodrero
Notes:	Doug Bodrero welcomed everyone. Sheriff Mike Spanos made a motion approve the February 22, 2000 and the April 28, 2000 minutes. Second: Gary Dalton. The motion was unanimously approved.

Agenda Item:	Mental Health Examinations – Ron Gordon
Notes:	Ron Gordon introduced Creighton Horton, Assistant Attorney General to explain the proposed criteria and standards for forensic examiners. This criteria will ensure that qualified people are charged with doing evaluations. Mike Sibbett made a motion to approve and support this outline. Second: Georgia Block.
