Notes	<p>Christine Watters reported five committees reviewed VOCA formula, sexual assault set aside, and Recovery Act grant applications submitted by governmental and non-profit organizations. Recommendations for VOCA funding are based on program priorities, eligibility requirements, allowable and unallowable services, activities and costs, application evaluations, funding histories, record of providing effective services, use of volunteers, 20% match requirements, and available funds. She reviewed the grant award recommendations and noted the VOCA Screening and Allocation Committees recommend funding 102 grants for a total of \$4,090,934.37.</p> <p>Motion: Reed Richards made a motion to approve the governmental Victim of Crimes (VOCA) grants.
